For new researchers, a preparation meeting will be held to help acquaint you with the FHL catalog and prepare for the trip. <u>Rooms</u> have 2 queen size beds, coffee maker, microwave, refrigerator, wireless hi-speed internet, and hair dryers. Room rates are per person for 7 nights, and include transportation and baggage handling to and from the hotel, and 1 hour seminar presented by Heritage Consulting. There is a restaurant attached to the hotel. <u>Deluxe rooms</u> are larger, have an extra vanity with sink (great for triple or quad occupancy) & have a view of the city (south side of the hotel). <u>Standard rooms</u> are slightly smaller (no extra sink) & face north with a view of the library, mountains, & / or parking lots. <u>Should you wish to spend additional nights at the hotel before or after the event ask for availability when you call in.
